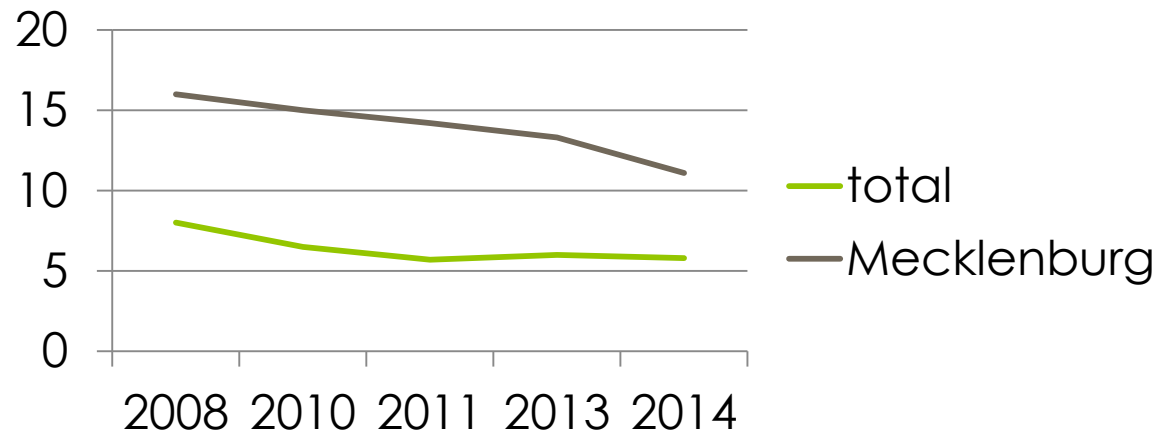
- Location of the national training Institution Deutsche Angestellten-Akademie (DAA- German academy for employees)
- Core competencies: in the field of training, education and arrangement of training and job-seekers.

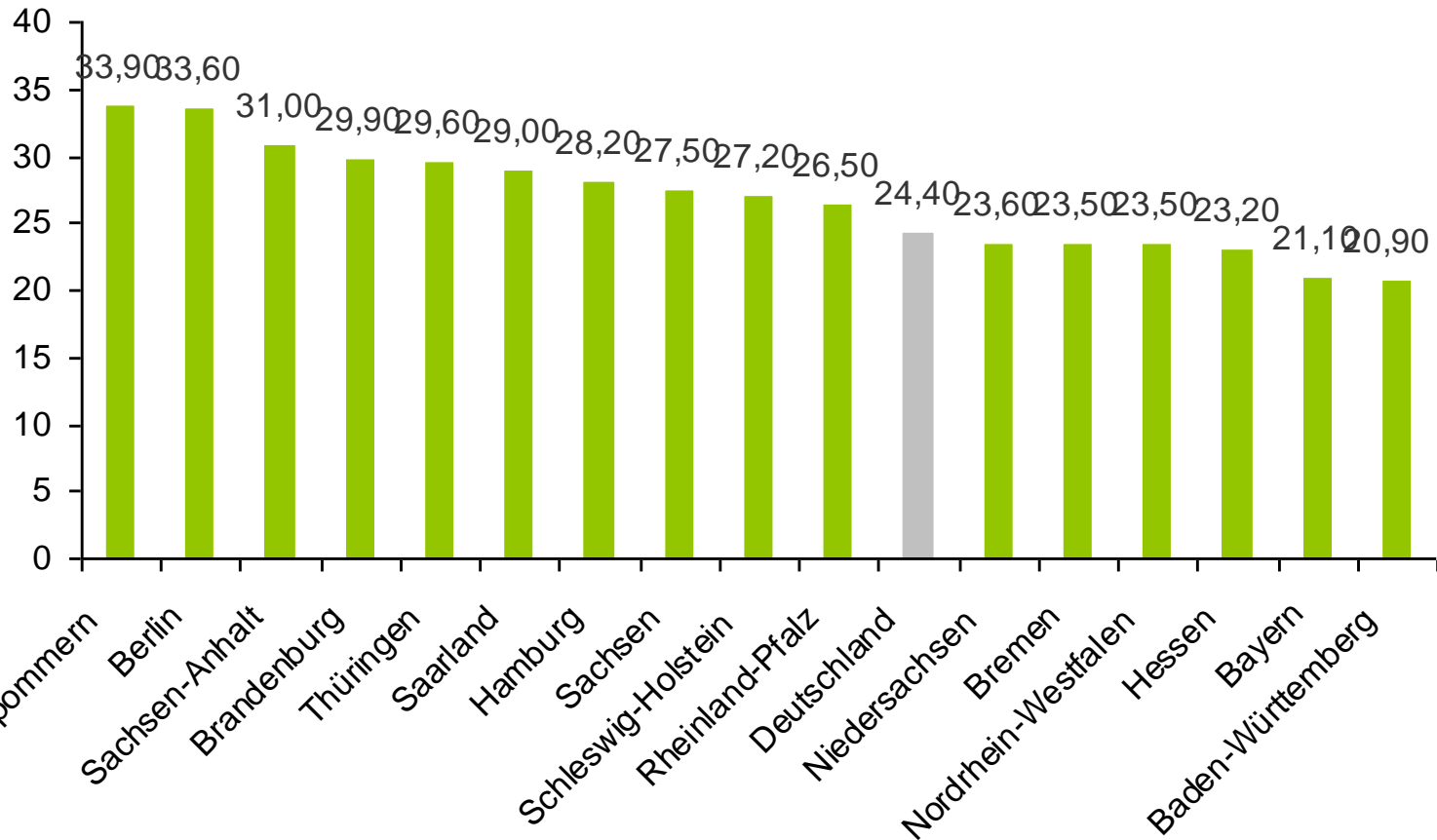


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2. Overview drop out rate in Germany

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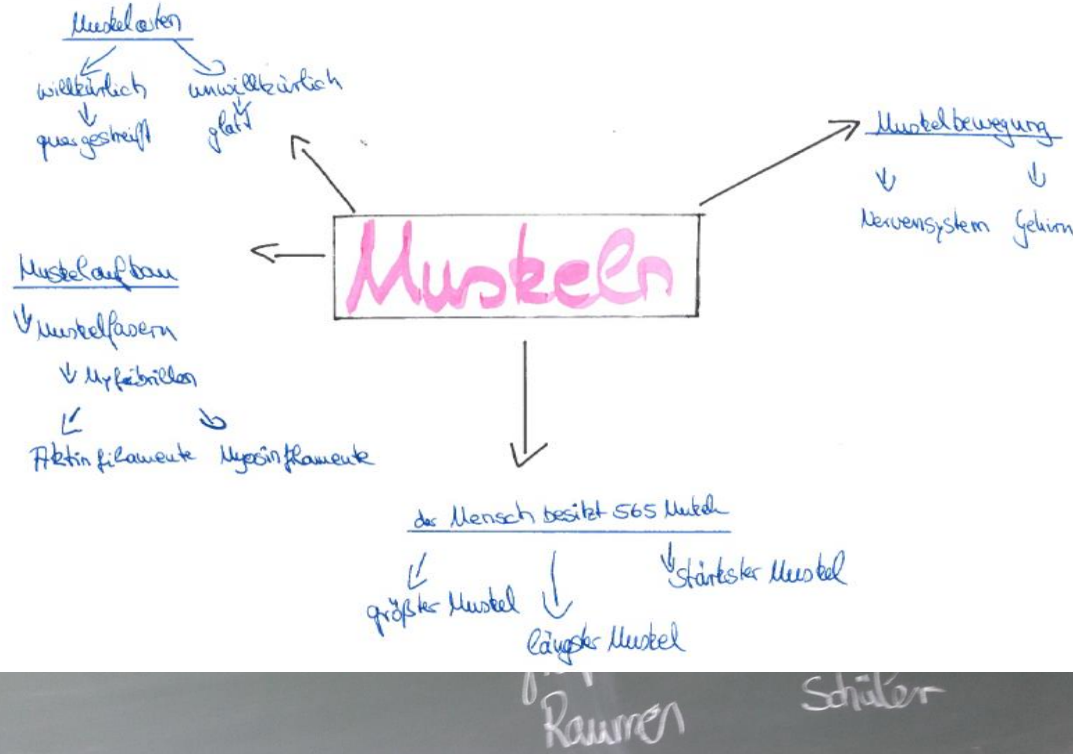
3.) STAY IN Project a) Analyse
